## Dress Code

Home of the "Bright Future"

- All students are required to wear the school's uniform as stated in the Parent Handbook.
- Boys and girls are required to wear a **TIES-issued dark green top**.
- Boys are required to wear solid khaki, solid black, or solid navy blue pants (no cargo pants). Girls may choose to wear a solid khaki, solid black, or solid navy blue skirt, jumper, or pants (no cargo pants). Skirts and jumpers have to be past the knees. All tights have to be solid white, solid dark green, solid black, or solid navy blue in color.
- Girls may wear a two-piece white, dark green, or light green scarf. Younger girls should tie their hair back if they choose not to wear a scarf.
- Boys may wear qalansuwahs. No other headwear for boys will be permitted.
- Boys are required to tuck their shirts into their pants.
- Outerwear Requirements – **TIES-issued dark green sweatshirts** only. In addition, if wearing a jacket, it must be solid dark green in color.
- Footwear Requirements – Boys and girls may wear athletic shoes or flat casual shoes. Sandals as well as shoes with heels, open toes, or wheels will not be permitted. Socks need to match the uniform (no bright colors).
- P.E. Requirements – Boys and girls may wear solid dark green sweats to school instead of their regular uniform pant on the P.E. days.
- No shorts or denim jeans of any color will be allowed.
- All students should wear a clean and neat uniform to school.
- All students are required to wear the **TIES-issued red t-shirt** on fieldtrips.
- Fridays are Islamic-dress days. The boys may wear dishdashahs and qalansuwahs. The girls may dress in ^abayas and head scarves. Students choosing not to wear Islamic dress on Fridays need to wear the TIES uniform.
