Dress Code: Elementary

All students are required to wear the school's uniform as stated below and in the Parent Handbook.

- All students should wear a clean and neat uniform to school each day.
- TOPS: All students are required to wear a **TIES-issued top**.
 - boys - light blue
 - girls - pink
- BOTTOMS: Boys are required to wear solid navy blue pants (no cargo, denim, or sweat pants). Girls may choose to wear solid navy blue pants, skirts, skorts, or jumpers (no cargo, denim, or sweat pants). Skirts, skorts, and jumpers have to be past the knees and worn with navy blue tights or leggings. No shorts or denim jeans of any color will be allowed. Boys are required to tuck their shirts into their pants.
- HEADWEAR:
 - Boys may wear qalansuwahs. No other headwear for boys will be permitted.
 - Girls are to wear a **TIES-issued two-piece scarf** (pink with navy blue). Younger girls should tie their hair back if they choose not to wear a scarf.
- OUTERWEAR Requirements: **TIES-issued navy blue sweatshirts or jackets** only.
- FOOTWEAR Requirements: Boys and girls may wear athletic shoes or flat casual shoes. Sandals, as well as shoes with heels, open toes, wheels, or cleats will not be permitted. Socks need to match the uniform (no bright colors).
- P.E. Requirements:
 - Students may wear solid navy blue sweat pants with a **TIES-issued red t-shirt** to school instead of their regular uniform pant on P.E. days.
- All students are required to wear the **TIES-issued red t-shirt** on fieldtrips.
- ISLAMIC-DRESS may be worn on Fridays.
 - Boys may wear modest dishdashahs and qalansuwahs.
 - Girls may dress in modest ^abayas and head scarves.
 - Students are not to be overly dressed in Islamic fashions, and those choosing not to wear Islamic dress on Fridays need to wear the TIES uniform.
